1. Youth bowlers must be Bismarck-Mandan USBC standard youth league or adult/youth league members. Adult bowlers may not be USBC Youth members and must be 18 years of age or older. Anyone with the option to enter as either a Youth or Adult must remain with their choice throughout the tournament.
2. Two divisions in Mother-Daughter ( 2 females); three divisions in both Father-Son ( 2 males) and Mixed ( 1 female, 1 male). Divisions will be based on youth bowler's average. Doubles partners are not required to be related.
3. Unlimited number of entries for both youth and adults, provided each entry is with a new partner.
4. Awards given to youth bowlers on a 1-for-4 basis. High youth handicap series in Mother-Daughter I \& II, Father-Son I, II, \& III and Mixed I, II,\& III receive $\$ 200$ scholarships and second high youth handicap series in each division receive $\$ 100$ scholarships. Note: A bowler may not receive both scholarships in the same category. In this case, the second place scholarship will be awarded to the next eligible bowler. Overall high boys and girls scratch series each receive $\$ 200$ scholarships. There will twenty $\$ 30$ Participation Scholarships; youth bowlers will be entered once for the drawings. All scholarships are administered by USBC - SMART Acct. 10725.
5. Youth bowlers use highest Feb. 8, 2024 USBC league average (min. 12 games). If no 12-game average as of that date, use average as of date 12 games are bowled, up to time of competing in tournament. Youth with no entering average bowl scratch.
6. Adults use first average from following order: A) 2022-23 USBC highest league average (min. 21 games); B) highest Feb. 8, 2024 USBC league average (min. 12 games); C) more recent USBC highest league average (min. 21 games) from 2021-22 or 2020-21 season; D) average of games bowled in this tournament over last three years; E) minimum assigned averages of 150 for men and 135 for women.
7. Each entrant will bowl 3 games. Handicap: $90 \%$ of 220 for 3 games. No limit.
8. Reserved entry deadline: February 25. Entries after February 25 will be accepted, subject to lane availability. Please contact Sheila McClenathan to make arrangements. Entries for each shift close 45 minutes prior to scheduled shift start time.
